Two bedroom property for 'affordable rent'

£1,400 more expensive per year

Two bedroom property for social rent





Affordable rent home in Arun district = £780 per month



Comparable social rent home = **£496** per month

That's a saving of **£284** every month





12,348 households on local authority waiting lists in March 2018 in local authorities in East and West Sussex, excluding Brighton.

60 new homes for social rent built

At current build rate, it would take $205\ years$ to meet the backlog





3,919 households on local authority waiting lists in rural authorities in Sussex in 2018

4 new homes for social rent built

At current build rate, it would take $980\ years$ to meet the backlog
