Here are some fun tree-based activities.

1

Tell your tree's story

Write a story from the viewpoint of a tree.

How did it start its life?

What has it seen over the years?

What does it see when all the people go to bed at night?

How high does it go?



Measure the height of a tree by holding a stick vertically and walking backwards until the stick is covering the whole tree. Measure the distance between you and the tree to get an estimated height.

Go tree spotting

See how many different trees you can spot in your local area in a week. Collect leaves and research to find out which trees they came from.

Natural paints

Use leaves, berries and herbs to mix different coloured paints then create a picture of a tree. Make sure you check with an adult which berries and herbs are okay to touch first!

Make the case

Imagine you are taking part in a debate about why trees matter. Come up with your own reasons why you love trees then make a poster or write a speech.
