Dear Miss [redacted]

I am writing concerning your registration with Northlands Wood Practice. We have to inform you that as you are no longer within our practice catchment area you do need to register with a practice nearer to where you live.

The reason we are no longer able to retain patients outside our catchment area is that in the event of a home visit being needed, it would take a doctor considerable time to conduct a visit to your home, and this inevitably detracts from time available for other home visits and clinics. Other health care professionals such as District Nurses would also not be able to visit you. It is our aim to provide the highest possible service to all our patients and therefore we cannot keep on patients outside our catchment area.

In order to give you adequate time to find a more local GP Practice, we are giving you 30 days' notice from the date of this letter. After this period of time we are obliged to de-register patients who are out of our area and return all medical records to the Health Authority.

May I request that you find a local GP Practice and register with them at the earliest opportunity. A comprehensive list of GP Practices can be obtained from NHS Choices at www.nhs.uk
