Background - Horsted Keynes

- Medium sized village
- ► HW AONB
- 2 Conservation areas
- ► 54 listed buildings
- Grade 1 listed church
- Within 7km Ashdown Forest zone of influence
- SSSI and Local Wildlife Sites
- Countryside area of development constraint
- But no NDP!
- Hence developer interest



Sledging Field

- Steeply sloping agricultural field
- Edge of the conservation area
- Adjacent to listed buildings
- Within the setting of the church
- ► Gap between the historic Saxon settlement and later settlement areas
- Application for 38 houses refused
- Appeal withdrawn
- Application for 9 large houses refused
- Appeal dismissed

- Register with PIN's
- What will you bring to the party?
