NOTE: We recognise that:

- Sharing photographs and films of activities can help us celebrate the successes and achievements of our children and young people, provide a record of activities and raise awareness of the school.
- The welfare of the children and young people taking part in activities is paramount and children, their parents and carers have a right to decide whether their images are taken and how these may be used, regardless of age, disability, gender reassignment, race, religion or belief, sex or sexual orientation.
- Consent to take images of children is only meaningful when children, their parents and carers understand how the images will be used and stored, and are fully aware of the potential risks associated with the use and distribution of these images and that there are potential risks associated with sharing images of children online.
- CPRE Sussex will seek to keep children and young people safe by: - always asking for the school or other organisation to provide written consent from a child/children and the school or their parents/carers before taking or using a child's image and will always explain what images will be used for, how they will be stored and what potential risks are associated with sharing images of children - make it clear that if a child or their family withdraw consent for an image to be shared, it may not be possible to delete images that have already been shared or published

- Changing the names of children whose images are being used in our published material whenever possible (and only using first names if we do need to identify them)

- Make sure children, their parents and carers understand how images of children will be securely stored and for how long (including how we will control access to the images and their associated information) reducing the risk of images being copied and used inappropriately by:
- only using images of children in appropriate clothing (including safety wear if necessary)
 - avoiding full face and body shots of children taking part in activities
- using images that positively reflect young people's involvement in the activity.
- CPRE Sussex will never publish personal information about individual children and disguise any identifying information (for example the name of their school or a school uniform with a logo)
- CPRE will also develop a procedure for reporting the abuse or misuse of images of children as part of our child protection procedures. We will ensure everyone involved in our organisation knows the procedures to follow to keep children safe
